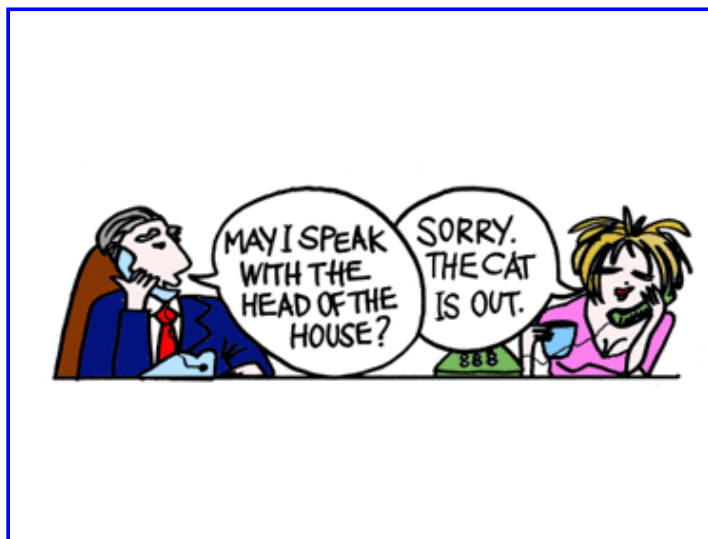


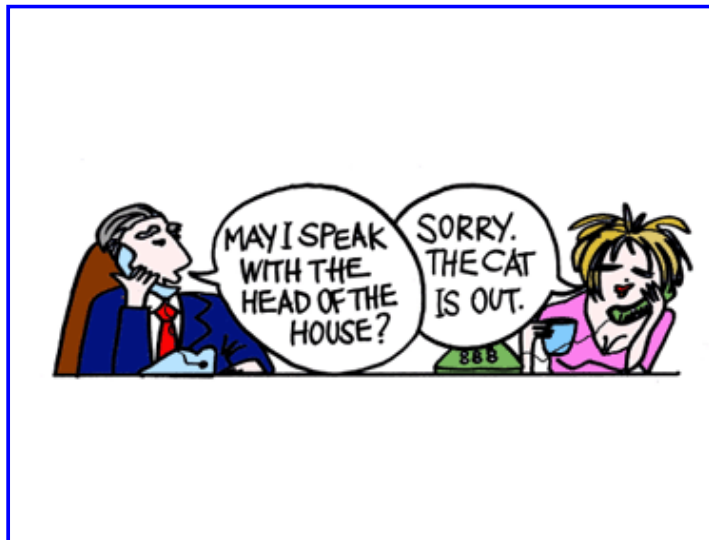
Men are simple things.

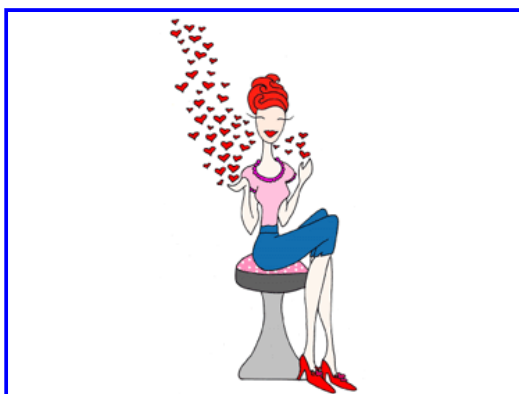
