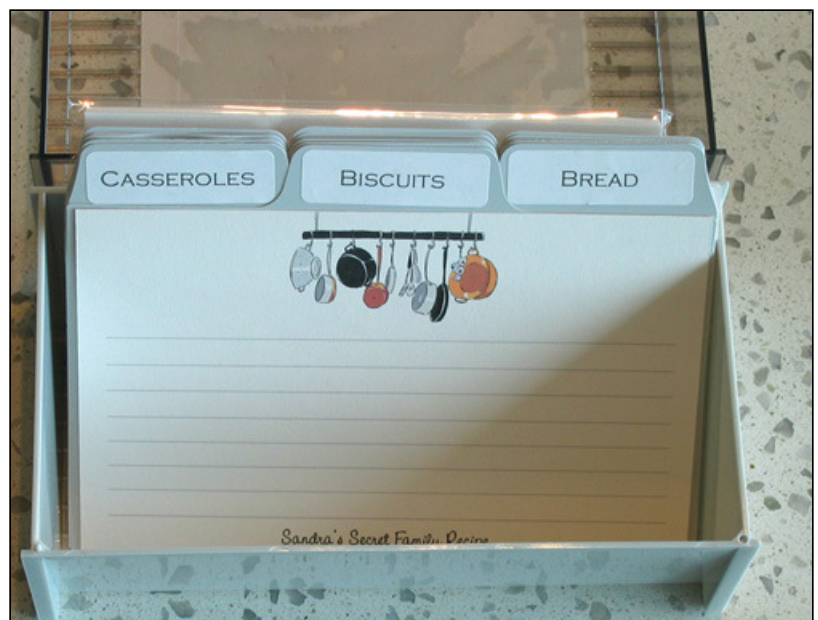
## Recipe Card Holder

I have received lots of requests for a Recipe Card storage box. Now as much as I would love to get a box made especially for Note Couture, minimum orders are generally 1000 items, I'm only a small business and I don't have the budget to carry, or the space to store, this sort of quantity. Plus I would need to get them made in China and I really only want to sell Made in Australia items, so I've come up with an alternate solution.



I've purchased some Esselte Index Card Boxes and Index Dividers. The Recipe Card Box can be personalised with one of our food illustrations plus your name or message - have some fun - eg: *Suzie Brown's Secret Family Recipes!* It comes with a page of self adhesive labels for you to stick onto the index dividers (eg: Chicken, Fish, Vegetables, Casseroles, Biscuits, Pasta etc) there are also a number of blank labels on the page so you can handwrite any additional categories you'd like to include.

It may not be Kikki K glamorous, but it is perfectly personalised. :-)





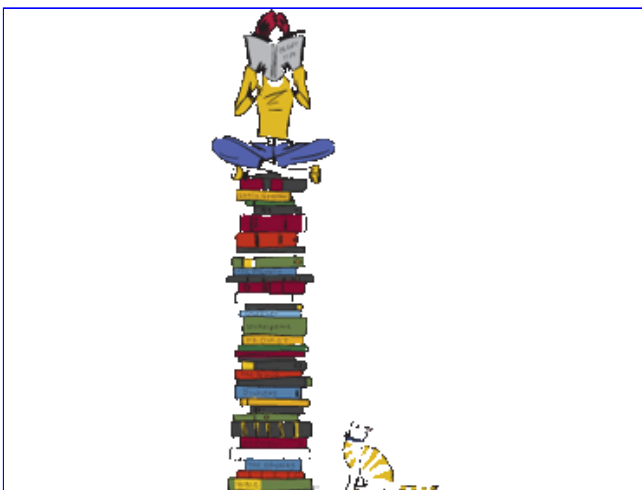

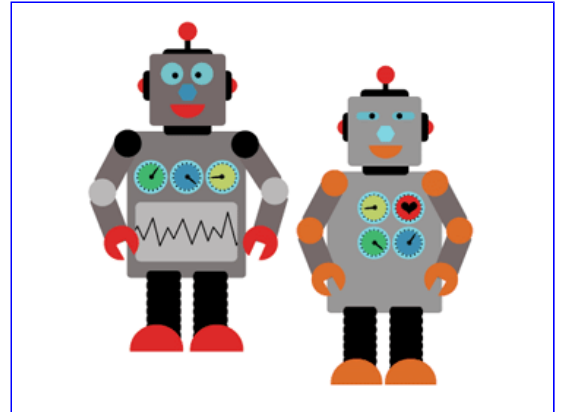

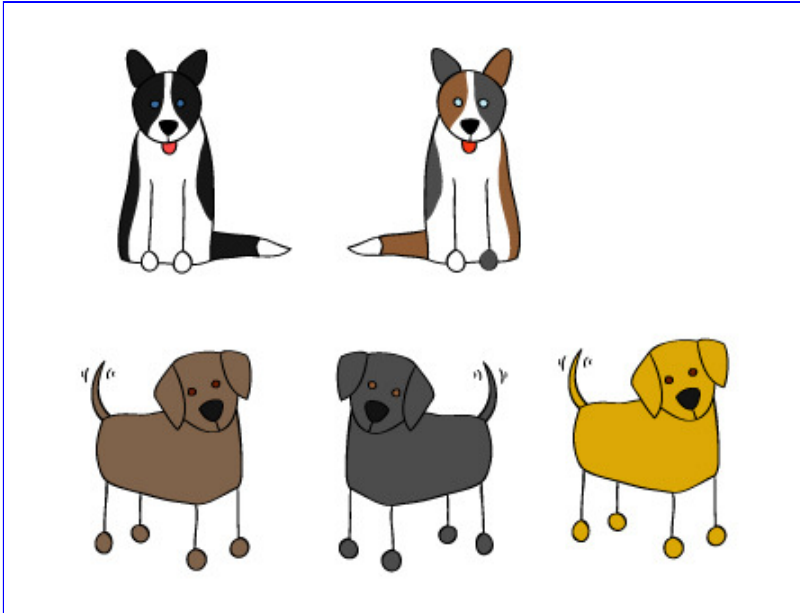
